welcomes the announcements made today in Tehran

on Iran's nuclear programme

In reply to questions from the Press, Javier SOLANA, EU High Representative for the Common

Foreign and Security Policy (CFSP), welcomed the announcements made earlier today in Tehran on

the occasion of the visit of the British, French and German Foreign Ministers:

"I warmly welcome the declaration made in Tehran today whereby the Iranian government

informed that it had decided to sign, ratify and immediately apply the IAEA Additional Protocol, as

well as voluntarily suspend uranium enrichment and processing activities.

I have been in contact with the Director-General of the IAEA, Mohamed El-Baradei, and with the

European Ministers during the process that led to today's declaration and I am pleased that it has

yielded these positive results. This is a major step forward and an important achievement for our

efforts.

Today's declaration, which must now be implemented, paves the way for a resolution of the Iranian

nuclear issue as well as for the further development of EU-Iran relations. It is positive for stability

in the region and for international efforts on non-proliferation."
